Re: Important SUMMER APPOINTMENT information for Physical Exams
with Dr. Byron. ***PLEASE READ***

If you would like to schedule an appointment to have your child's sports physical done by Dr. Byron please call Jean Wilbur @ 692-9542 ext. 4217. Please note appointments will only be made for the scheduled dates on the enclosed calendar. Please plan accordingly. If your child is unavailable during the dates that are provided please call your primary doctor to schedule an appointment. Some doctor's offices schedule physicals one to two months out so please call as soon as you receive this packet. Please note special accommodations **will not** be made.

Appointments will be made for **JV and Varsity Sports Aug 9th thru the 12th and Aug 16th. Modified Sports** will be scheduled for **Aug. 30th**.

On the day of your child's scheduled appointment please be sure to have your child arrive **on time** so his/her weight, height and blood pressure can be measured prior to seeing the doctor. Also please have your child bring the health assessment form (included) completed and signed by you. Without this health assessment form your child **will not** get their yellow card and will not be able to participate in practice.

If for any reason your child misses his/her appointment without calling to reschedule, your child will have to wait until **all** scheduled students have been seen by Dr. Byron. This may take place after your child's sport season has started so please be sure your child arrives to his/her scheduled appointment.

If you have a child going into 7th or 10th grade the sports physical can also be used for the NYS mandated physical exam. There is no need to have two separate physical exams done. However if this exam is done privately it must be forwarded to my office by mail or fax to meet both requirements.
