

# Test Corrections

Test corrections should be done on a separate piece of paper, neatly, and handed in stapled to your test. You will receive  $\frac{1}{2}$  credit you missed back on each correctly completed test correction you hand in. Follow the examples below:

## Multiple Choice:

1. Write out the question as a full sentence with the answer included.
2. Underline your answer in the sentence you have created.

## **Example:**

8. Most scientists believe the First Americans directly came from Siberia before crossing to America.

## Matching:

1. Write out the term to be matched
2. write the definition of the term next to the term

## **Example:**

6. civilization - ad. an advanced culture

## Short Answer:

1. Write out the correct answer entirely, make sure to echo the question.

## Essay:

Completely re-write the essay including the information that had been previously missing. You do not have to re-write you old answer to the question.

Map: You cannot do test corrections for maps.
