- 10. STAMPING UP FUN!** **3-4** **Christa Campbell**
 Get out the ink! Come and make interesting crafts and projects using all sorts of rubber stamps. We'll use a variety of paper, ink and stamps to create a photo album or a scrapbook for you to take home and fill with cool stuff about you.
- 11. NIMBLE THIMBLE** **3-6** **Terry Mumby**
 Want to learn to sew? Make some crafts and a project to take home? In this class you will learn the basics of the sewing machine and some hand sewing stitches. We will work with different fabrics and construction methods. You will leave class with a finished project! *Both weeks will be held at Ruby's Nimble Thimble located on Main Street in Greenwich. Parents will need to pick up and drop off students at that location Monday through Friday – week one and Monday through Thursday week two (August 6-16 at 9:00-11:00am). The sewing machines and materials are provided.
- 12. EVERYTHING GUITAR** **4-5** **Chelsie Henderson**
 Want to learn how to play that guitar you have? This class is for you! Beginning guitarists will have the chance to learn how to strum a tune, and learn basic techniques. You will also learn about the guitar itself and you'll even have the chance to build your own box guitar. (Please note: You will need your own guitar for this class. A limited number can be borrowed by special request. Please indicate this on your registration.)
- 13. HOMEMADE THEATRE** **4-6** **Sarah Moses**
 Give my regards to Broadway! Come create and put on a play. Design and build sets and costumes for an off (way off) Broadway performance. Then, "break a leg"!!
- 14. FUN FOTOS** **4-6** **Cliff Oliver**
