Medication Guidelines

The following information should help you in making arrangements for your child to have their medications while at the overnight field trip at Camp Chinghacook.

Students may not have any medications in their possession. Students who have Doctor's orders to self-administer their own asthma inhalers may carry their inhalers. However, the Health Office must have this documentation on file. If your child already has an inhaler in the Health Office, it will be sent on the trip with the teacher.

If your child takes daily medication that he/she will need on the trip, please bring the medication to the Middle School Health Office by 8:00 A. M. on the day of your child's trip. Medications may be brought in sooner than that if necessary. Parents must bring the medications in. Students are not allowed to carry medications to and from school. All medications must be in their original containers with their original labels affixed to them. Your child's name must be on the container. This includes all over the counter medications as well.

Please send only enough medication for the duration of the trip. Your child's teachers will dispense the medication.

If your child has a bee sting or food allergy, please contact the Health Office prior to the trip.
