

The Joan Grishkot Memorial Foundation Scholarship

**APPLICATIONS ARE NOW BEING ACCEPTED FOR THE 2024
SCHOOL YEAR**

The Joan Grishkot Memorial Scholarship provides funding for residents of New York State who reside in Warren, Washington or Saratoga county to pursue the study of nursing, physical therapy, occupational therapy and other related medical support fields. Undergraduate premedical and graduate medical studies are excepted. Non-traditional students pursuing nursing as a second career are particularly encouraged to apply.

The scholarship is given in memory of Joan Grishkot of Glens Falls, a long-time nurse, public health executive and community leader, and co-organizer of the Adirondack Balloon Festival.

At least two scholarship awards of at least \$2,500 per year, for up to four years, depending on the number of qualified applicants in any given year. Additional one year scholarships may be awarded, depending on available funding.

Scholarship renewals are contingent on the recipient remaining in the applicable program and being in good academic standing.

The Grishkot Foundation, a 501(c)(3) volunteer nonprofit organization, conducts the scholarship program in collaboration with the Glens Falls Kiwanis Foundation.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the Grishkot Foundation's Joan Grishkot Memorial Scholarship, the applicant must:

- Be a graduating high school senior, a past recipient, or a returning adult planning to enroll in an undergraduate or graduate course of study at an accredited postsecondary institution for the next academic year.
- Be a resident of New York State who resides in Warren, Washington or Saratoga county.
- Demonstrate academic success, school and community involvement, leadership skills, a strong work ethic and exhibit creative thinking.
- Be pursuing a career in of nursing, physical therapy, occupational therapy or other related fields.

Awards

If selected as a recipient, the student will receive an award of \$2500 per year, for up to 4 years of school, assuming the award winner meets the necessary criteria each school year: the recipient continues in studies of nursing, physical therapy, occupational therapy or other related fields and is in good academic standing.

Presentation & Payment of Awards

The Foundation will present the scholarship award in a check made payable to the recipient in late June 2024.
