"NAZZIE" was a Fort Ann Central School Graduate

In January 1971 he began his 35-year Law Enforcement career as a Deputy with the Washington County Sheriff's Office. In January of 1979 he was promoted to the rank of Sergeant and in 1980 he was promoted to Lieutenant, the rank he held till his passing in 2006.

Nazzie loved sports and cared about his Officers, community, family and was well respected by all that knew him. He was known for his dedication and love for Washington County, The Sherift's office, and its members.

In 2007 the Washington County Sheriff's Office welcomed a black lab to it's K9 patrol which was named "Nass" after Lt. Nassivera. K9 "Nass" was certified in narcotics detection, tracking, building searches, search and rescue and patrol. K9 Nass was retired from the Sheriff's Office and unfortunately passed in 2019.
